RPYC 2019 Time Trialling Season

1. RULES

The event will be governed by the current rules for the sport of Time Trialling by the Cruising Power Yacht Committee of Yachting Western Australia (Inc).

2. ENTRIES

Boats registered with RPYC are eligible to enter this event in accordance with RPYC rules. All skippers must be financial members of a YWA affiliated club.

4. SCHEDULE

This schedule describes the events which will constitute the RPYC 2019 Time Trialling season. Times and dates may change without notice but the event will still stand.

5. SCORING

Scoring for Championship shall be determined from least points lost, and for Consistency shall be from points lost, Handicap and events competed in. All races described in the Schedule shall be included in the calculations of these results. A total of 9 events will constitute a series.

6. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded for;

- the winners of the Championship on least points lost for the 2019 season, the competition board 100 will also be awarded to these winners.
- the winners on Consistency for best handicap results for the 2019 season, the competition board 101 will also be awarded to these winners.
- Trophies will be awarded at the End of Season Celebration on 1 October 2019 at RPYC.
- NB. Winners on Championship are ineligible to win on Consistency.

7. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall accept that participation in the event is entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, RRS, Decision to Race. The OA, its officers, servants and other agents accept no liability in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of a competitor's participation or intended participation in the event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.

8. INSURANCE

All boats shall have valid third party liability insurance with minimum cover of not less than \$10,000,000. All owners/competitors who nominate shall be deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.
