## Red Varietals

**Karri Oak – Cabernet Merlot 2015, WA** 30

Karri Oak Cabernet Merlot is full of plum character with hints of blackcurrant from the Margaret River region of Western Australia

**Ferngrove Symbols – Cabernet Merlot 2015, WA** 40

The Ferngrove Cabernet Merlot is juicy and fleshy with mulberry and blackberry fruits, raspberry and spice. Winner of the Silver Medal at 2015 Qantas Wine Show of Western Australia

**Howard Park – ‘Miamup’ Cabernet Sauvignon 2014, Margaret River, WA** 55

One of the stalwarts of the Margaret River wine making region, highly rated in James Halliday's Wine Companion with average scores in the mid 90's.

**Carpe Diem ‘Decantato’ – Sangiovese 2015, Margaret River, WA** 55

A ‘super Tuscan’ blend that is a favourite at RPYC.

## Shiraz

**You, Me & the Gate Post – Shiraz 2016, WA** 20

With plum and mulberry characteristics this Shiraz is easy on the palate with soft tannins underpinning a slightly dry finish.

**Cape Mentelle – ‘Marmaduke’ Shiraz 2014, Margaret River, WA** 45

Soft and spicy red wine, which exhibits the regional expression of Margaret River and varietal intensity of Shiraz, another consistent highly rated wine.

**Rockbare – Shiraz 2016, McLaren Vale, SA** 60

A fantastic well balanced wine that keeps you coming back for more. Rated as Outstanding 95 points in James Halliday's Wine Companion.

**Penny Hill's – ‘Cracking Black’ Shiraz 2015, McLaren Vale, SA** 70

A fantastic Shiraz that has been awarded 93 Points by Wine Front, and received a Gold Medal at the Mundus Vini Grand International Wine Award 2017 and Gold Medal at the San Francisco International Wine Competition 2017.

## Dessert Wine

**Vasse Felix ‘Cane Cut’ – Semillon 2013, WA** 49

The Vasse Felix Cane Cut has complex aromas of lemon meringue and ginger nut, with hints of vanilla spice. A lovely viscous, silky mouthfeel provides richness and texture.

**Stella Bella – Pink Moscato 2012, WA** 49

Pink Moscato draws upon the authentic Moscato wine style, made from this same grape. The wine is sweetly fruity, low in alcohol and lightly fizzy (or frizzante).

## Riesling/ Pinot Grigio

**Frog Belly – Pinot Grigio 2017, Margaret River, WA** 10

From the multiple award winning Warner Glen Estate in Margaret River.

**Sevenhill ‘Inigo’ – Riesling 2016, Clare Valley, SA** 10

Displays pure varietal character with vibrant citrus perfume and delicate floral aromas.

## Rosé

**Zilzie Selection 23 – Rose 2017, Murray Darling, VIC** 8

Selection 23 Rosé is fun and flirty and knows how to stand out in a crowd. Made from a luscious blend of Shiraz and Sangiovese grapes, this rosé has the best of both worlds and isn't afraid to show it.

**Rameau d'Or – Rose 2017, Cote De Provence, France** 12

Dry, delicate rosé showing the traditional tones of rose from the sunny Provence area of Southern France. Notes of wild strawberries and delicate spicy notes. An outstanding southern French rosé.

## Pinot Noir

**Fat Bastard – Pinot Noir, 2015, France** 10

On the full-bodied end of the spectrum, the Fat Bastard Pinot Noir is a spectacular drop that challenges you to live large.

**Snake & Herring – Pinot Noir 2017, Margaret River, WA** 12

The 2017 Wide Open Road Pinot Noir is an early release style of Pinot Noir. A bright red hue, the 2017 Wide Open Road is another evolution in the early drinking Pinot Style.

## Cabernet Merlot

**Moët & Chandon – Brut Champagne, France** 110

**Sevenhill 'Inigo' – Riesling 2015, Clare Valley, SA** 55  
Displays pure varietal character with vibrant citrus perfume and delicate floral aromas.

## Pinot Grigio

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**Howard Park – 'Flint Rock' Chardonnay 2016, Mount Barker, WA** 60  
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
