Commodore's list

Vasse Felix Heytesbury - Chardonnay 2012, Margaret River, WA \$120

The Chardonnay was fermented entirely with wild yeasts and matured in French oak barriques with battonage for nine months. A juicy acid line combined with a fine, powdery texture sets a taut canvas for complex, elevated peach, lemon, lime and baby pineapple flavors that build and hit their stride in the long finish.

Pierro L.T.C - SSB, Chardonnay 2014, Margaret River, WA \$70

The classic blend is 50% Semillon, 45% Sauvignon Blanc and 5% Chardonnay. The wine has restrained aromatics, some lemon citrus notes and dried herb complexities, while the palate is subtle and delicate showing fruit purity and delicious tanginess. There is tight structure with power building before a finish featuring refreshing, zesty natural acidity. A fresh lively wine that seems to sparkle and dance in the glass.

Cullen - Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2010, Margaret River, WA \$78

It is a naturally fermented wine blended with 79% Cabernet Sauvignon and 21% Merlot. It displays ripe, densely flavoured fruits complemented by fine-grained tannins. The Cabernet Sauvignon was matured in French oak barrels for 18 months. Cellared for 10 years, perfect drinking right now.

Penny's Hill - 'Skeleton Key' Shiraz 2016, McLaren Vale, SA \$80

A deliberately long-aged expression of the cumulative best from their McLaren Vale vineyard site, 'Skeleton Key' is cellared and carefully bottle-aged before it is unlocked. Awarded 95 points by James Halliday, an outstanding wine.

Tai Nui – Sauvignon Blanc, 2019, Marlborough, NZ

"Tai" in Maori translates to "tide" and "Nui" translates to "high". From the renowned Marlborough region in New Zealand famous worldwide for their Sauvignon Blanc.

Cape Mentelle – ‘Georgiana’ Sauvignon Blanc, 2018 WA

Georgiana is a fresh, vibrant expression of Margaret River Sauvignon Blanc. Continuously rated above 90 points in James Halliday's Wine Companion.

Juicy and vibrant in flavour yet pale in colour, this wine displays fresh herbal notes and citrus fruits.

Pinot Noir

Plantagenet Three Lions ~ Pinot Noir , Great Southern, 2020, WA 55
They are wines with power and provenance, with the coat of arms recognized by many as a symbol of quality and prestige.

Red Varietals

Chain of Fire ~ Shiraz 2020, WA 20
With plum and mulberry characteristics this Shiraz is easy on the palate with soft tannins underpinning a slightly dry finish.

Folklore ~ Cabernet Merlot 2020, WA 30
Blackberry, bay leaf and red earth with fine and velvety tannins, matured in French oak for 8 months. 2019 Perth Royal Wine Awards - Gold Medal

Wild Flower ~ Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, WA 40
The Ferngrove Cabernet Merlot is juicy and fleshy with mulberry and blackberry fruits, raspberry and spice. Winner of the Silver Medal at 2015 Qantas Wine Show of Western Australia

Howard Park ~ 'Miamup' Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, WA 55
One of the stalwarts of the Margaret River wine making region, highly rated in James Halliday's Wine Companion with average scores in the mid 90's.

Shiraz

Forester Estate ~ 'LifeStyle' Shiraz , 2017, Margaret River, WA 45
Soft and spicy red wine, which exhibits the regional expression of Margaret River and varietal intensity of Shiraz, another consistent highly rated wine.

Rockbare ~ Shiraz 2018, McLaren Vale, SA 60
A fantastic well balanced wine that keeps you coming back for more. Rated as Outstanding 95 points in James Halliday's Wine Companion.

Dessert Wine

Vasse Felix 'Cane Cut' ~ Semillon 2014, WA 40
The Vasse Felix Cane Cut has complex aromas of lemon meringue and ginger nut, with hints of vanilla spice. A lovely viscous, silky mouthfeel provides richness and texture.

Kingston Estate ~ Pinot Gris 2019, Adelaide Hills 10
Rated 91 points 2019 James Halliday Wine Companion

Rosé

Forester Estate Rose ~ Rose 2020, Margaret River, WA 9
Selection 23 Rosé is fun and flirty and knows how to stand out in a crowd. Made from a luscious blend of Shiraz and Sangiovese grapes, this rosé has the best of both worlds and isn't afraid to show it.

Rameau d'Or ~ Rose 2018, Cote De Provence, France 12
Dry, delicate rosé showing the traditional tones of rose from the sunny Provence area of Southern France. Notes of wild strawberries and delicate spicy notes. An outstanding southern French rosé.

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Wild Flower ~ Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, WA 9
Sourced from Margaret River this wine is boasting intricate flavours and fine tannins. It is fruitful and vibrant With dark berries, plum fruit and a delicious texture.

Pinot Noir

Plantagenet Three Lions ~ Pinot Noir , Great Southern, 2020, WA 11
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Champagne

Moët & Chandon – Brut Champagne, France 110
Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial with its perfect balance of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier has become one of the world's most loved Champagnes.

Veuve Clicquot – Brut Champagne, France 120
Veuve Clicquot is the enduring homage to the great Madame Barbe-Nicole Clicquot. A wonderful celebration Champagne.

Brown Brothers – Crouchen Riesling 2017, VIC 40
Brown Brothers are well known for their quality sweet style wines and created the ever popular Crouchen Riesling that exhibits aromas of white peach, pear, even a little lychee.

Castle Rock Estate – Riesling 2020, Porongurup, WA 40
94 Points "Castle Rock's Porongurup Riesling is a benchmark for the region. From the look of this wine 2020 is going to be a good vintage, if a little earlier drinking than usual. .
