

DIGGERS' CUP SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & COURSES 25th APRIL 2018

The Diggers' Cup race will be a handicap start

These instructions are to be read as part of the printed Sailing Instructions

START PROCEDURE: Rule 26 is deleted and replaced with the procedure that follows. TEN minutes before the start of the race, the Class Flag and Course Flag will be displayed on one hoist accompanied by a sound. SIX minutes before the start the number "65" will be displayed. ONE minute before the start, number "60" will be displayed and fall after ONE minute.

Countdown to Fall numbers 60,55,50,45,40,35,30,25,20,15,10,5 and 0 may be broadcast over VHF Ch77

START SIGNAL: Boats shall start at or after the FALL (when their number disappears) of their allotted handicap number. Each number will be displayed for ONE minute. The FALL of a boats allotted handicap number will be that boats signal to start.

A boat starting before the fall of her allocated handicap number will be penalised ONE minute for each full minute or part thereof that she starts early plus TWO minutes. This penalty will be added to her actual finishing time for the race. Recall signals will not be made. A boat cannot exonerate starting before the fall of her handicap number. Boats shall not pass between the inner start line mark and the start box with their sails up during the start sequence. Boats doing so may be disqualified by the race committee without hearing.

CLASS FLAG Naval Numeral 1 (Boats are not required to display Class Flags)

COURSE FLAG Numeral pennant 1,2,3 or 4 will be displayed showing the course to be sailed.

SHORTENED COURSE The Course may be shortend in accordance with Rule 32 & race signals

DAY BUOYS Day buoys 1,2 will be large orange inflatable buoys. Only day buoys specified in the designated course will be in the water. Please note the approximate position of the day buoys is shown on the river marks map provided.

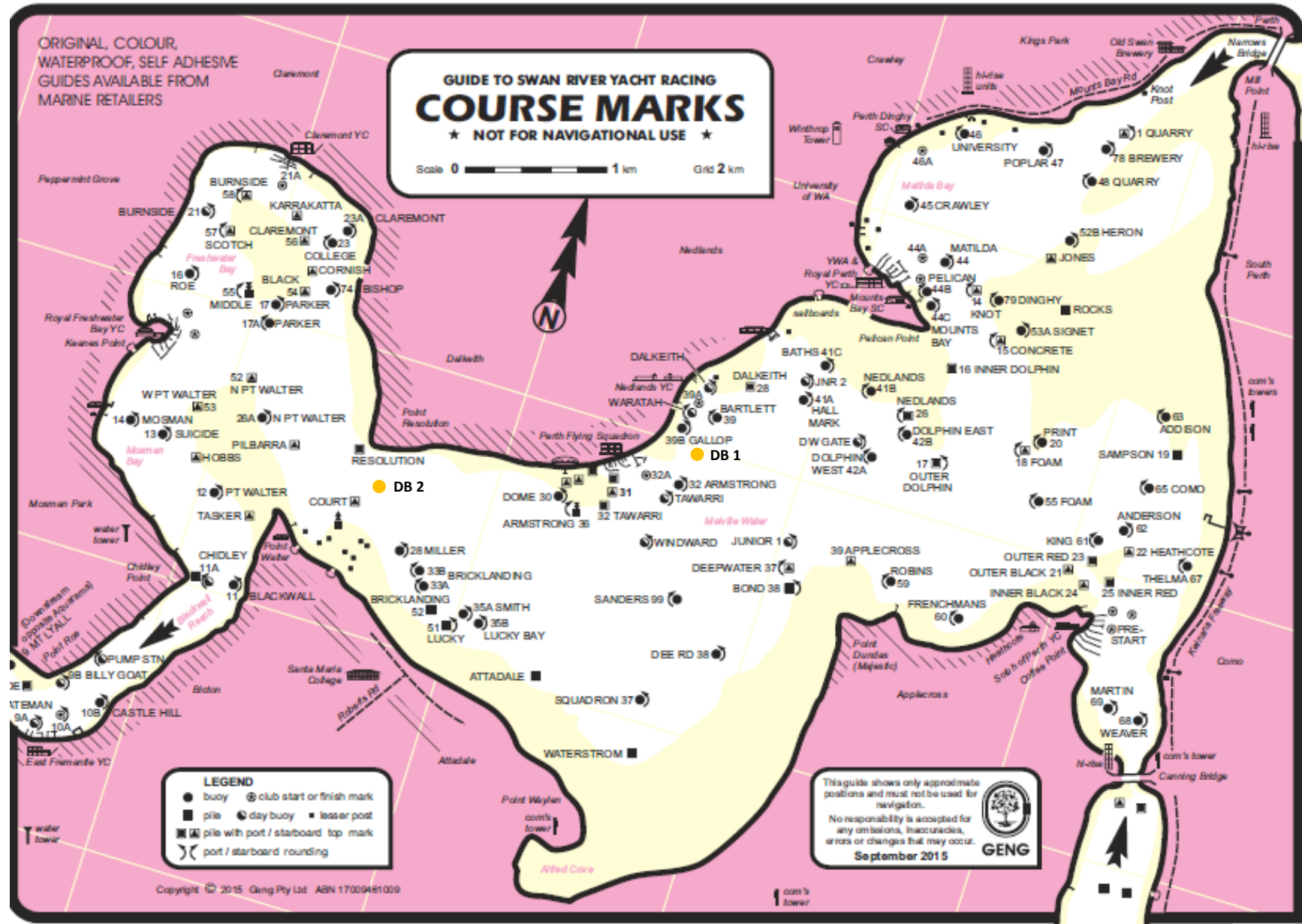
