# **NOTICE OF RACE**

## 1. RULES

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

## 2. ADVERTISING

World Sailing Advertising Code (Regulation 20) shall apply.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 All yachts in all fleets must be to a 1975 or prior design – Exemptions by discretion of the SRRYSOG

3.2 Yachts accepted for entry in the SRRYS will be classed as follows

Division 1: Sloop/Bermuda & Gaff rigged

Division 2: Sloop/Bermuda & Gaff rigged

Division 3: Sloop/Bermuda & Gaff rigged

As designated by handicap and at the discretion of the SRRYSOG.

3.3 Eligible yachts may enter by completing the online entry form which will be available for download from [www.rpyc.com.au](http://www.rpyc.com.au) , [www.rfbyc.asn.au](http://www.rfbyc.asn.au) websites. The completed form with the required entry fee shall be lodged with RPYC for the complete event or individual races Oct-Jan, Individual races Feb – April shall be lodged with RBYC. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the SRRYSOG.

## 4. FEES

4.1 An entry fee of \$120 for the 7 race series shall apply which must be lodged together with the Entry Form as per 3.3.

4.2 From race 2 onwards, an individual race entry fee of \$20 can be paid, to be received together with the completed Entry Form no later than 1600 on the Wednesday before the particular race being entered.

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

SRRYS Sailing Instructions will be available from the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018, from both the RPYC and RFBYC websites.

Changes to Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Organising Authorities (for that scheduled race) website and posted on the additional website where possible.

## **7. RACING AREA**

The racing area will be the Swan River including Melville Waters, Freshwater Bay, Matilda Bay and Canning River.

## **8. COURSES**

The SRRYS Sailing Instructions will include all courses for the series.

## 9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A4.1 will apply as modified by the Sailing Instructions. Handicaps will be provided by the SRRYSOG to entered boats prior to the series commencement, and will be adjusted and updated throughout the series.

## 10. PRIZES

The **SRRYS Perpetual Trophy** will be awarded to the overall handicap winner of the Combined Fleets section of the series.

Division winners and placegetters will receive the following prizes as cash or voucher.

Prizes given as cash or voucher will be presented to the winners and placegetters at the Prize Night Dinner (Date and time to be confirmed).

The 2018-2019 SRRYS Season will include a Trophy for yachts launched 1939 and prior. The trophy will be awarded to the first eligible yacht with the lowest point score in the Combined section of the fleet as determined by the overall Combined Fleet points score calculation.

## 11. RESULTS

Results will be posted on the Organising Authorities website (for that race) as soon as practicable.

## 12. SAFETY

The AS Special Regulations 2017-2020 (Part 1) apply. The yacht registered in this event complies with the above regulations and any OA/YWA amendments and requirements in respect to Category 7 Safety.

## 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the series at entirely their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the series.

## 14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or equivalent.
