



RPYC eSailing Series – Virtual Regatta Inshore

- The RPYC eSailing Series will utilize the Virtual Regatta Inshore (VRI) online sailing simulator. This is a free to play program.
- The RPYC eSailing Series is open to current Members of RPYC.
- All competitors must register to participate in the RPYC eSailing Series.
- Registrations must be made via the online registration link on the RPYC Website prior to racing. Registrations for each day will close at 0900 on that day. They will re open once racing has been completed on that day (this is to allow time for the administration, and emails to be sent out to competitors with all information for the days racing)

- Only those participants who have registered will be provided a Code which enables entry to the RPYC online races.
- The Racing Rules of Sailing within the game are the rules of the RPYC eSailing Series.
- VRI's automated penalty system will be the accepted governance of racing within the RPYC eSailing Series.
- Races or parts thereof may be recorded for educational purposes.
- Internet or VRI connection issues does not constitute a claim for average points.

Race Day Series:

- A Race Day Series will consist of 3 consecutive races.
- There will be a number of Sessions conducted to ensure that all registered get to compete in a Race Day Series on any given day.
- Each session's start times will be as stated in the schedule of races in the email received on the morning of each race day. As a competitor you will be able to enter your race code 3 minutes prior to race start which will allow you to be on course for the next scheduled race.
- There are no drops for each Race Day Series.
- Races are limited to 19 competitors. RPYC Boating Office Staff will become the Administrators for each race and are required to host a race within VRI. This will mean the 20th competitor within the races will be an RPYC Staff Member.

Race Day Fleets:

- Racing will be split into sessions. The overall number of competitors will be split each race day into equal groups to fill each session.
- At 1000hrs each race day the Boating Office will email each competitor with the schedule of races for their session and the race code required to gain access to their allotted session.
