

# **Hyatt Regency Perth Summer Series 2020/2021**

## **Supplementary Sailing Instructions**

*These Supplementary Sailing Instructions are to be read as part of the 2020/21 Royal Perth Yacht Club Sailing Handbook (Redbook).*

### **Divisions of Fleets:**

Division A – Boats normally racing in Division 1, BW36, BW8 & Etchells

Division B – Boats normally racing in Division 2, Farr 9.2 & S80

Division C – Boats normally racing in Division 3, T-Birds & Endeavour24

Boats can be moved around Divisions at the discretion of the Wednesday Committee

### **Start & Finish Lines**

Line “A” as described in the RPYC Handbook (Redbook)

### **Course Numbers**

The course for each class shall be designated by the display of the appropriate International Numeral Pennant prior to the first warning signal.

### **Class Flags**

Division A – Naval Numeral “A”

Division B – Naval Numeral “B”

Division C – Naval Numeral “C”

Boats are not required to carry Class Flags

### **Sails**

The use of spinnakers is not permitted but headsails may be changed providing the new sail uses the same forestay and halyard as the original sail.

### **Shortened Course**

Courses may be shortened in accordance with RRS 32 or by the following method:

As the leading boat of any division approaches Inner Dolphin, Flag “S” will be displayed with two sounds accompanied by a flashing light. All Divisions will then proceed directly to Finish from Inner Dolphin passing through the Finish Line in a North Westerly direction.

### **Retirement**

The Skipper on any retiring Boat shall inform Staff in the Boating Office immediately after returning to the pen. Any Skipper failing to do so will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF).

### **Time Limit**

Boats failing to finish by 1730 will be scored as DNF

### **Late Starters**

Boats starting later than 4 minutes after their Starting Signal shall keep clear of any boats preparing for their allocated start and until their first mark.
