

Twilight Supplementary

Sailing Instructions 2021/22



These Instructions are to be read as part of the printed Sailing Instructions within the 2021/22 RPYC Sailing Handbook (Redbook).

- Lights:** The attention to all skippers is drawn to DoT Regulations that all craft must carry the required navigation lights after sunset. Failure to do so may result in the Skipper receiving a substantial fine as this infringes the Navigable Waters Regulations
- Divisions:** Division A – Boats normally sailing in Division 1/S97/BW8/Etchells
Division B – Boats normally sailing in Division 2/S80/Farr 9.2
Division C – Boats normally racing in Division 3/Endeavour 24
- Start Times:** See 2021/22 RPYC Sailing Handbook as start times vary through the season
- Start Line:** Line “A”
- Finish Times:** The cut off for finish times of the twilights are published as part of these SSI’s. If Boats wish to proceed after this time, they will no longer be participants of the event and will be responsible for themselves from that time until they return to their Pen.
- Finish Line:** Line “A”
- Class Flags:** Division A – International Code Flag “A”
Division B – International Code Flag “B”
Division C – International Code Flag “C”
- Identification:** Skippers are advised that as they are crossing the finish line a torch must illuminate the numbers on your sail. If this is not able to happen, Skippers must communicate that they are crossing the finish line on VHF CH77.
- Special Rules:** Skippers are to note that the Rules for the Prevention of Collision at Sea Regulations prevail after sunset and boats shall not sail above a proper course to the next mark.
- Spirit of Twilights:** Twilight is a traditional RPYC social outing for which a special spirit of behaviour prevails:
Skipper are expected to resolve all differences without the need to lodge a protest, however the Racing Rules of Sailing apply and protests will be accepted.
- Sails:** Spinnakers shall not be used; headsail changes are permitted.
- Shortened Course:** A shortened course will be signalled by a white strobe light on the start box and shall be communicated via VHF CH77.
