## **Royal Perth Yacht Club – Sailing Instructions 2022/2023**

### **1. Rules**

Races will be governed by the rules as defined by:

- 1.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. The Australian Sailing Special Regulations (ASSR).
- 1.3. The Australian Measurement System (AMS) rules where applicable.
- 1.4. The International Rating Certificate (IRC) rules where applicable.
- 1.5. The RPYC Handicapping System Rules, where applicable.
- 1.6. The penalty for breaking SI 2.5, 2.6, 5, 8.2 & 13 will be a 30% scoring penalty calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c) (changes RRS 64.2).
- 1.7. Boats may not protest under SI 2.3, 2.5, 2.6, 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 8.2 or 14.4 (changes RRS 60.1(a)).
- 1.8. Based on its own observation or on receipt of a report from a disinterested party, the RC may, without a hearing, penalise a boat with a 30% scoring penalty for breaking SI 2.5, 2.6, 5, 8.2 or 14.4 (changes RRS 63.1).  
A hearing will be granted upon receipt of a valid request for redress lodged within an hour of the last boat finishing that session.
- 1.9. RRS Appendix T – Arbitration will apply.
- 1.10. RRS 44.1 is changed so that any penalty excluding RRS31 received within the Zone remains as a two-turn penalty. Any penalty outside the Zone changes to a one-turn penalty.

### **2. Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1. Boats shall nominate online prior to competing in a race in a series. Only boats registered at the Club may compete in Club races unless the race is designated as an invitation race or unless otherwise approved by the Boating Operations Manager. Failure to nominate may result in a handicap of 0.999.
- 2.2. Boats wishing to compete in “special” events shall enter in accordance with that events Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

- 2.3. Boats shall submit a completed Australian Sailing Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form for the category of racing they will be competing in before their first race in that series or special event.
- 2.4. Skipper, Change of Skipper.
  - 2.4.1. The skipper of a boat is the person on-board who is responsible for the competent and safe operation of the vessel.
  - 2.4.2. The nominated skipper for a series shall be the owner/co-owner. Where the nominated skipper is not the owner/co-owner, that person shall be a Full Member, Honorary Life Member or Centreboard Member of RPYC.
  - 2.4.3. For races where the RPYC Elliott 7's are competing, the nominated skipper shall be a financial Member of RPYC unless approved by the Race Committee.
  - 2.4.4. The Race Committee shall be notified when a boat intends to sail with a skipper other than its nominated skipper, by submitting in writing to the Boating Operations Office. Notification of 'Change of Skipper' shall be made to the Boating Office no later than one hour prior to the scheduled start time of that race.
  - 2.4.5. The alternate skipper shall be a financial Member of RPYC when competing in RPYC Consistency or Championship Series. The intent of this clause is to enable another category of Member of RPYC to skipper a boat on a temporary, short-term basis. These categories include, but are not limited to, Crew and Social Member categories.
  - 2.4.6. After a boat's warning signal during RPYC Championship Series Racing, the nominated or alternate skipper shall not leave the helm except in the case of an emergency.
- 2.5. Boats shall have a minimum of two crew inclusive of the helmsman. Whilst sailing double-handed both crew shall wear PFDs at all times while afloat and both shall be capable of sailing the boat.
- 2.6. Any advertising and/or logos on boats and/or sails must be approved by the Regatta Committee, to whom all requests should be submitted.



- 2.7. The Sailing Rig shall consist of an all-white, long or short sleeved shirt with collar and all white shorts or trousers, alternatively sailors may wear black shorts or trousers. In the event of inclement weather, coloured waterproofs are permitted. Whilst the wearing of all white sailing rig is not mandatory for Offshore Sailing Events, the wearing of "whites" is strongly encouraged. This Instruction shall not apply to "Twilight Cruises" and Off The Beach Racing. See RPYC By-Law 7.10. Visiting boats shall comply with their own Club's dress requirements.
- 2.8. Visiting Boats shall be on the Boat Register of another Club affiliated to Australian Sailing and are required to enter by nominating with the RPYC Boating Office no later than 60 minutes before their first warning signal on the day of the race.

### **3. Measurement**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate for the competition in which they will be competing in, if required by the competition in which they will be competing.

### **4. Notices to Competitors**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the Notice Board located inside the Foyer at RPYC and may be posted on the event page in the RPYC website.

### **5. Safety Regulations**

- 5.1. All keel or ballasted boats shall comply with the following:
- 5.1.1. **Wednesday, Saturday & Frostbite Racing:** ASSR Part 1, Category 7.
- 5.1.2. **Night Series:** ASSR Part 1, Category 7 with the addition of:
- 2 x Red Handheld Flares in a waterproof container
  - 2 x Operational Waterproof Torches
  - PFD's to be worn at all times whilst afloat
  - All boats must Sign On/Off via VHF CH77 with RPYC Start box

5.1.3. **Twilight Cruises:** ASSR Part 1, Category 7 with the addition of:

- 2 x Red Handheld Flares in a waterproof container
- 2 x Operational Waterproof Torches

5.2. All boats are required to have the PFDs and First Aid Kit sections of their Safety Audit Form completed by a qualified AS Auditor. The Auditor may also spot check other components within the form to ensure compliance.

5.3. All boats are required to have an operational VHF Radio whilst participating in any RPYC organised event and VHF CH77 will be monitored to cater for any emergency during the event. Equipment Auditors will need to sight your VHF before finalising your 2022/23 Audit.

5.4. No boat shall race with an anchor protruding over its bow.

## **6. Sign On**

6.1. All boats shall Sign On with the Race Committee prior to the start of their scheduled race online via the link provided on the associated series on the Royal Perth Yacht Club webpage.

6.2. It is the Skipper's responsibility to record themselves and all other persons on-board their boat. Boats that fail to Sign On for three (3) consecutive races or more shall receive a 30% scoring penalty without a hearing for the third breach and each consecutive breach.

## **7. Changes to the Sailing Instructions (SI's)**

7.1. Any change to these sailing instructions will be posted one hour before the race on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day prior to it taking effect.

## **8. Signals Made Ashore**

8.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagstaff on the Australia II Ceremonial deck.

- 8.2. Flag Y with one (1) sound signal shall mean; competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. When flag Y is displayed ashore, this rule applies at all times while afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. See RRS 40.

## **9. Schedule of Races**

Racing is scheduled as per the Schedule of Events 2022/2023 located in the RPYC Redbook.

## **10. Division and Class Flags**

- 10.1. A boat shall race in the Division/Fleet to which it has been allocated by the Boating Operations Manager in consultation with the various race day committees.
- 10.2. Division and Class flags are as shown in Appendix A.
- 10.3. During Saturday Summer Series all keelboats shall display their Division/Class flag approximately 2 metres above the deck on either the backstay or starboard shroud. Etchells and BW8 are exempt.
- 10.4. When racing as an individual class within a Division, each keelboat shall also display that particular Class flag below her Division flag.

## **11. Racing Areas**

Races will be conducted on the Swan River using laid courses or fixed mark courses.

## **12. The Courses**

- 12.1. Keelboats shall, subject to the provisions of section 12.4 of these Sailing Instructions, sail the courses published on the course sheets which will be made available to boats online at [www.rpyc.com.au](http://www.rpyc.com.au)
- 12.2. On Special Course Race Days, the course sheets will be made available online and will be sent electronically to all boats registered for the series.

- 12.3. Division and Class course numbers will be signalled on the Race Committee Start Vessel or at the Start Box, by the display of the corresponding Numeral Pennant, with or before the Warning Signal.
- 12.4. Any approved RPYC Saturday course may be altered using a Day Buoy as described in SI 13.1
- 12.5. RRS 34 is amended to add "If a mark of the course is missing or significantly out of position, boats shall round at the approximate position of its usual location."
- 12.6. All navigation posts that are not a mark of the course shall be passed on their deep-water side excepting "Outer Dolphin Spit", "Deepwater Spit", which may be passed on either side.  
All such navigation posts shall rank as obstructions for the purposes of RRS Part 2 and RRS 19 shall apply.

### **13. Marks**

- 13.1. The Day Buoy:
  - 13.1.1. Will be a large orange inflatable Buoy laid to windward of the Start Line.
  - 13.1.2. Signalled by the display of flag Q at the Start Line.
  - 13.1.3. Passed on the hand indicated by a red (port) or green (starboard) flag displayed immediately below flag Q, before continuing to the first mark of the course indicated for the day.
- 13.2. The approximate location of the marks of the course can be found on the Course Marks Map in the centre of the Redbook.

### **14. Areas that are Obstructions**

- 14.1. Boats shall not sail within the area bounded by the four navigation marks at Heathcote Channel whose area is deemed an obstruction. See Appendix C.
- 14.2. Boats shall not cross the imaginary line between Bricklanding A & B Buoys (33A & 33B). This line is deemed an obstruction. See Appendix C.



- 14.3. Boats shall not cross the imaginary line between Smith Buoy (35A) & Lucky Bay Buoy (35B). This line is deemed an Obstruction.  
See Appendix C.
- 14.4. Any other Club's start line that is "On Station" with the Orange or Blue flag shown shall be deemed an obstruction, except when that boat is competing in a race conducted by the relevant Club.

## **15. The Start/Finish**

- 15.1. Start Line A will be between the Orange Flag on the starting box and the Yellow Inflatable Cylindrical Buoy. Finish Line A will be between the Blue Flag on the starting box and the Yellow Inflatable Cylindrical Buoy. The inner extremity of the Start/Finish Line will be indicated by a White and Red Striped Buoy. For the purpose of RRS Part 2, Section C this will be considered a Starting Mark.
- 15.2. Start Line B will be between a Mast displaying an Orange flag on the Race Committee Start Vessel at the starboard end and a Yellow Inflatable Cylindrical Buoy at the port end.
- 15.3. Any boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS.
- 15.4. The mid river finish line for BW8 courses will be between the Orange flag on the Race Committee Vessel at the starboard end and a Yellow Inflatable Cylindrical Buoy at the port end.

## **16. Change of Course**

- 16.1. Prior to the start:
  - 16.1.1. The shortened course signal for each Class or Division shall be designated by the display of flag S with or before the respective Class or Division signal. This amends RRS 26 and Race Signals.

**16.2. After Starting**

16.2.1. All courses may be shortened at any rounding mark of the course in accordance with RRS 32 and Race Signals.

16.2.2. The shortened course for Wednesday races will be written on the Divisions course sheets for that series. This amends RRS 32.2 and Race Signals. Additional information may also be broadcast over VHF CH77.

**17. Time Limits and Target Times**

17.1. Unless otherwise specified in the Fleet Course Sheets or Supplementary Sailing Instructions boats that fail to finish by 1730 on Wednesdays, Saturdays or Frostbites will be scored DNF.

17.2. Time Limits for Twilight Cruises will be Nautical Sunset as published in the Redbook Schedule of Events.

**18. Protests and Requests for Redress**

18.1. Protests and Request for Redress shall be in writing and lodged to either the Boating Operations Manager, Boating Services Officer or Race Officer of the day. Protest forms are available from the Boating Office or the Main Yacht Club's foyer. This amends RRS 61.3.

18.2. The time limit for protests shall be 60 minutes after the last boat finishes in the last race of the day. This amends RRS 61.3.

18.3. The penalty for the breach of RRS 46 is at the discretion of the Protest Committee.

18.4. Protests not resolved at Arbitration will usually be heard on the second Tuesday evening after the event. The Boating Office will contact all Boat representatives and advise of the particular time and date of the hearing.

**19. Scoring**

19.1. Saturday, Frostbite and Night Series.

19.1.1. The RPYC Handicapping rule, or IRC/AMS rules when appropriate, shall apply unless the Sailing Instructions specify another system and shall be applied according to RRS A3.

19.1.2. RRS A5.3 shall apply except that the end of A5.3 is amended to read "... a boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place three (3) more than the number of boats that came to the starting area".

19.2. The handicapping systems for the Wednesday series are as shown in Appendix B.

19.3. Average points may be requested in writing to the Boating Operations Manager when a boat is unable to compete in RPYC Club competition when representing the Club at another Association, State or National level event. Average points will be calculated using all race scores excluding the race being claimed for average points.

19.4. Saturday Keelboat Consistency Series.

19.4.1. Each RPYC boat will be scored points for her finishing place on handicap. Where boats from other Clubs compete within the same race, scores for the Club Consistency will be awarded on the handicap finishing order of the RPYC boats.

19.4.2. Each RPYC boat competing in an invitation race at another Club, nominated as a RPYC Consistency event for that Class or Division shall be scored points for her finishing position on the handicap finishing order of RPYC boats.

19.4.3. The number of races to be discarded will be as shown in the table below:

<b>Number of Races Completed</b>	<b>Number of Drops</b>
0 - 4	0
5 - 7	1
8 - 10	2
11 - 13	3
14 - 16	4
17 - 19	5
20 - 22	6

19.5. Saturday Keelboat Club Championship Series.

19.5.1. Club Championship points will be awarded to each eligible boat participating in the races selected to constitute the series as indicated in the Race Schedule.

19.5.2. Each RPYC boat will be scored points for her finishing place on Championship. Where boats from other Clubs compete within the same race, scores for the Club Championship will be awarded on the championship finishing order of the RPYC boats.

19.5.3. All Class fleets will be eligible for Club Championship trophies in the following series:

19.5.4. The number of races to be discarded will be as shown in the table below:

<b>Number of Races Completed</b>	<b>Number of Drops</b>
0 - 4	0
5 - 7	1
8 - 10	2

**20. Radio Communications**

20.1. The Race Committee will use VHF CH77 to advise competitors of matters relating to the conduct of racing. Except in an emergency, competitors shall not make or receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

20.2. All boats are required to report all Man Overboard incidents via VHF to the Race Committee as soon as practicable following the event.



## **21. Prizes**

- 21.1. Saturday Summer Season Prizes will include:
  - 21.1.1. Championship Prizes will be awarded to those fleets that have a Championship Series assigned, either fleet over the line or AMS.
  - 21.1.2. Consistency Prizes will be awarded to all fleets.
  - 21.1.3. The Keith Williamson “Mercedes” Trophy will be awarded to the boat from any Division or Fleet with the most fastest times across all races in the previous winter and summers series’.
  - 21.1.4. The Commodore J B Fitzhardinge Trophy will be awarded to the boat from any Division or Fleet that sailed the most number of race days during the Summer season.
- 21.2. Wednesday Series Prizes will include:
  - 21.2.1. The Bombay Cup will be awarded to the boat from any Division or Fleet with the most fastest times.
  - 21.2.2. The winner from each Division for each of the Miniseries within a season.
  - 21.2.3. The first three places in each Division on consistency for the season.

## **22. Disclaimer of Liability**




- 22.1. All those taking part in races conducted by Royal Perth Yacht Club do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- 22.2. The Royal Perth Yacht Club, any sponsor and any party involved in the organisation of the event disclaims any and every responsibility for any loss, damage, injury to persons and things, both ashore and at sea, as consequence of participation in any way in the races covered by the Club’s Redbook and Sailing Instructions.
- 22.3. Attention is drawn to RRS 3 which states, “The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is theirs alone”.

**23. Insurance**









- 23.1. Each participating Boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or the equivalent.

## **Appendix B – Wednesday Series Handicapping Systems**

### **1. Handicap Parameters**

- 1.1. Only three digits will be used for Wednesday Handicapping
- 1.2. Division A and B handicaps will be adjusted as follows:
  - 1.2.1. First-place getters will go up by 0.010
  - 1.2.2. Second-place getters will go up by 0.005
  - 1.2.3. Third-place getters will not be adjusted.
  - 1.2.4. All other starters handicaps will go down by 0.002
- 1.3. Division C handicaps will be adjusted as follows:
  - 1.3.1. First-place getters will go up by 0.006
  - 1.3.2. Second-place getters will go up by 0.003
  - 1.3.3. Third-place getters will not be adjusted.
  - 1.3.4. All other starters handicaps will go down by 0.003
- 1.4. Handicaps of boats claiming average points for various reasons will be treated as DNC.

### **2. Arbitrary Manual Adjustments**

- 2.1. A first-place getter winning by more than one minute on corrected time will have their handicap raised by a minimum of 0.013
- 2.2. Boats gaining consecutive places (first, second or third) on corrected time, receive a further penalty according to the place gained in the second race:
  - 2.2.1. Third place receives an extra 0.001
  - 2.2.2. Second place receives an extra 0.002
  - 2.2.3. First place receives an extra 0.003
- 2.3. Boats gaining three or more consecutive places must be reassessed by the handicappers.

### **3. Start of Season Adjustment**

- 3.1. All boats that have won or gained a second or third place in the Consistency Series may have their handicaps raised from 0.002 to 0.015, depending on their winning margin.



- 3.2. All handicaps will be adjusted to group boats with similar performance ability.
- 3.3. Other factors involved in calculating start of Series handicaps include:
  - 3.3.1. Expected conditions, such as lighter winds in Winter, or stronger Sea Breezes in Summer.
  - 3.3.2. Starting and finishing handicap of previous Series.
  - 3.3.3. Handicap when boat achieved podium positions throughout completed Series.

#### **4. Scoring for Consistency Trophies**

- 4.1. Any boats that Do Not Finish (DNF) or Retire (RET), shall be scored as the number of finishers in that race plus two, but not lower than fourth place and not more than their respective fleet size on the day.
- 4.2. In the case of a whole division not being able to finish their race, or a race being abandoned after the start, all starters will score two-thirds of the number of boats in that race to the nearest lower number, but no lower than 8, this amends 4.1.
- 4.3. Boats being On Course Side (OCS) or Disqualified (DSQ) will score the number of boats in their fleet on that day plus one.
- 4.4. All boats that Did Not Compete (DNC) will receive a score equal to the number of Entries in that division at the end of that miniseries plus 2. This number may be readjusted at the end of each miniseries. This number will be displayed on the top right corner of the Wednesday Scoring Sheets.
- 4.5. Results will be calculated as follows:

Number of Races Completed	Number of Drops
19 – 21	6
22 – 24	7
25 or more	8

If extreme circumstances prevent the above from occurring the Wednesday Handicappers will assess the number of drops according to the number of races completed for the season.

## **5. Miniseries**

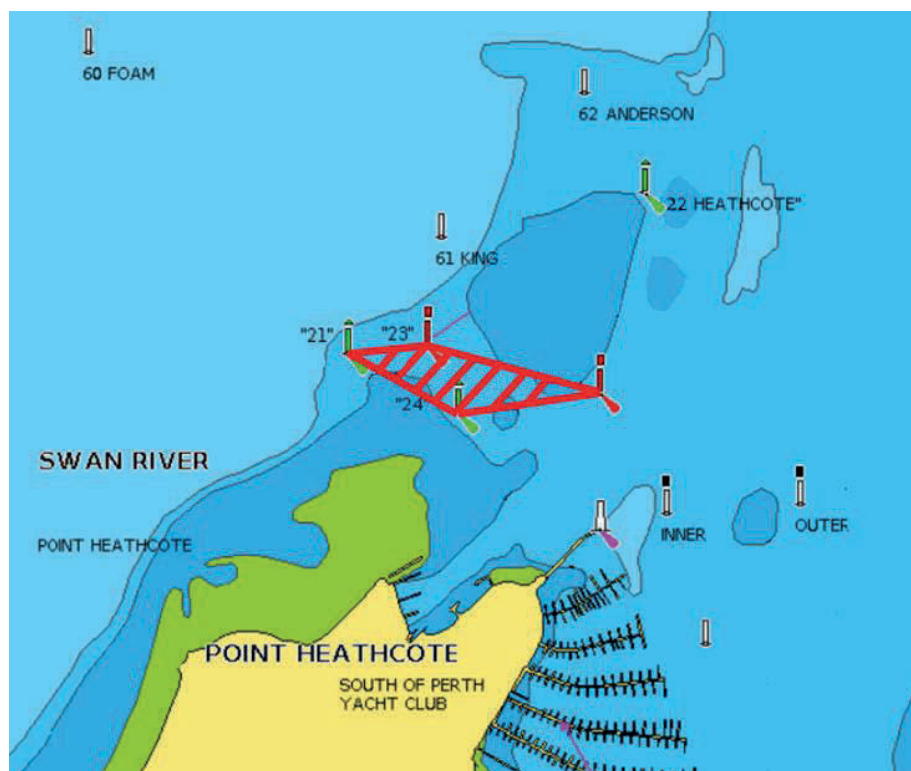
- 5.1. There are three miniseries per season, usually conducted over 8 races.
- 5.2. Every race in each miniseries is counted towards the final result of that miniseries.
- 5.3. First place for each miniseries, within a season, is awarded at the Presentation Lunch.

## **6. Request for Average Points**

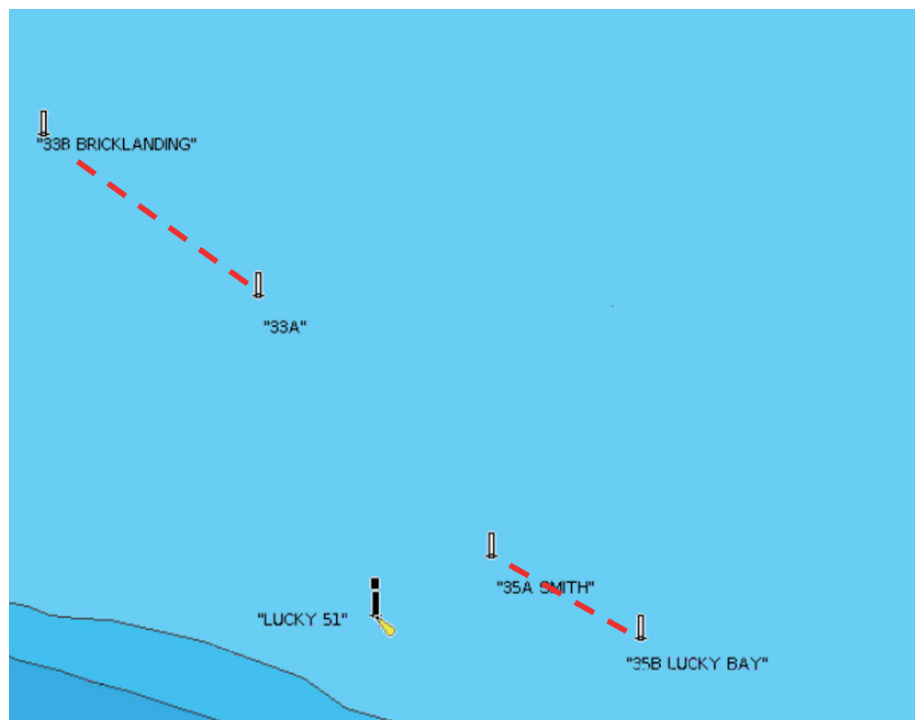
- 6.1. These may be granted for missed races upon written application to the Boating Operations Manager
- 6.2. If a boat applies for average points within the first miniseries the score will be calculated at the end of that miniseries.
- 6.3. If a boat applies for average points at any stage after the conclusion of the first miniseries, the average score is calculated using results up to the date of application.
- 6.4. At the discretion of the Boating Operations Manager and Wednesday Committee, average points may be awarded for the following reasons:
  - 6.4.1. Race(s) missed due to a boat being absent while competing at another Regatta,
  - 6.4.2. Whilst the skipper is volunteering at a significant RPYC or another Club event,
  - 6.4.3. In the event of damage sustained while being the right of way boat, whilst racing.

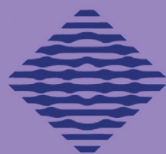

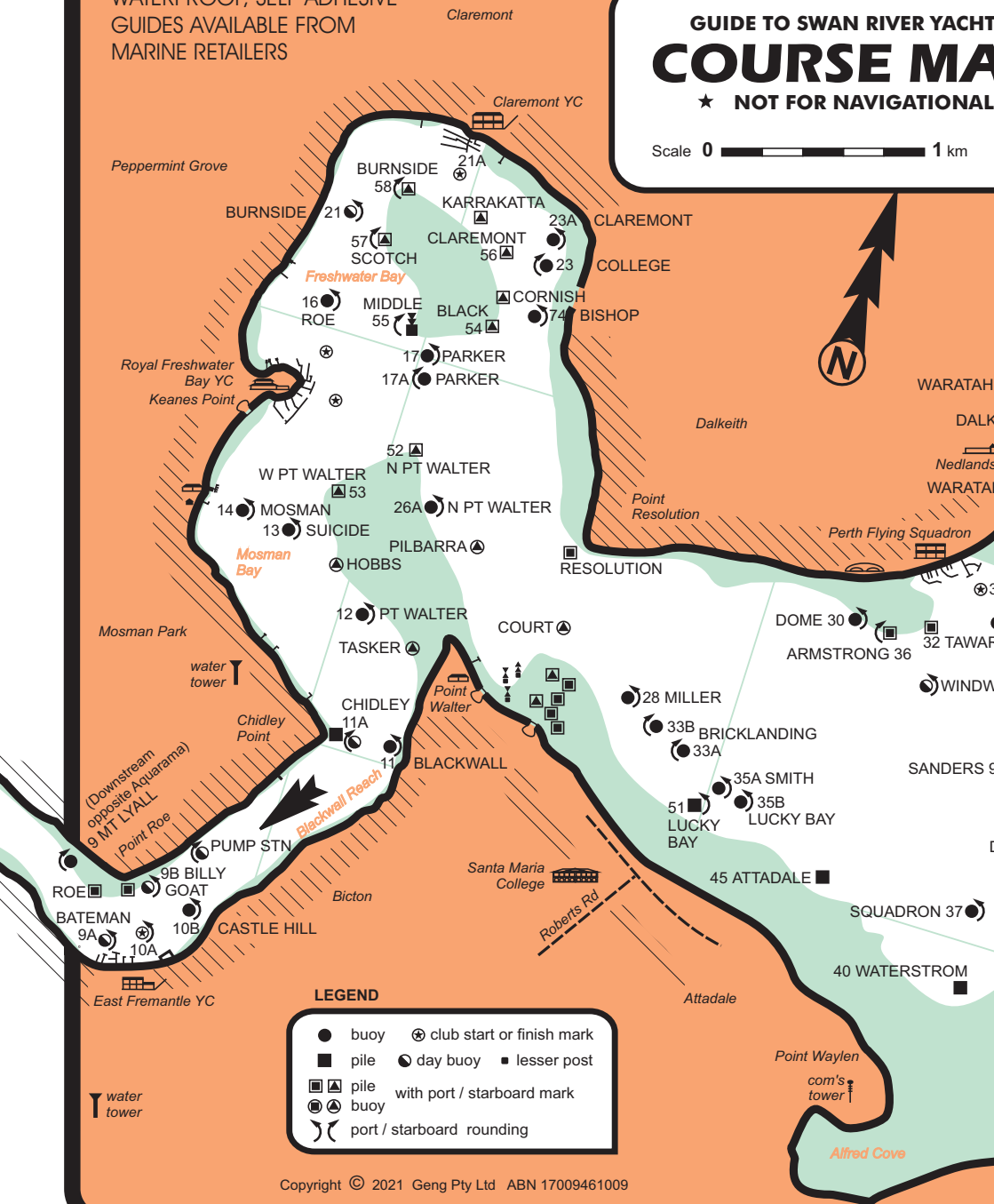

# Racing Rules of Sailing

## The Basics

### Sportsmanship & the rules

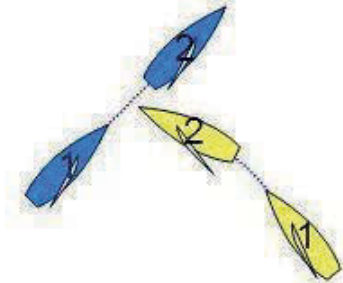
Competitors in the sport of sailing are governed by a body of rules that they are expected to follow and enforce. A fundamental principle of sportsmanship is that when a boat breaks a rule and is not exonerated they will promptly take an appropriate penalty or action, which may be to retire.

### Right of Way

A boat has right of way when another boat is required to keep clear of her.

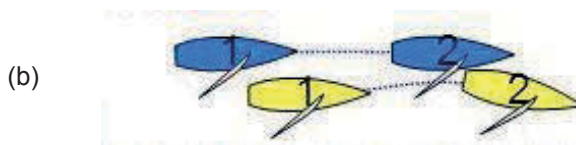
### Keeping Clear

(a) A boat keeps clear of another if the other can sail her course with no need to take avoiding action.



(a) Blue was not keeping clear because the Right Of Way (ROW) boat (Yellow) could not sail her course.

(b) And when the boats are overlapped on the same tack, the Leeward boat must be able to change course in either direction without immediately making contact with the Windward boat.



Blue above was not keeping clear because there was immediate contact when Yellow, the boat with ROW, changed course.

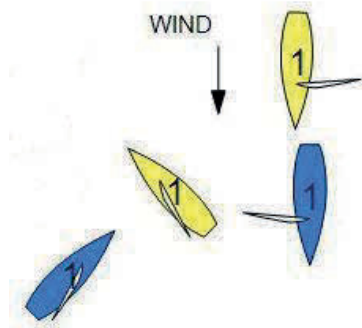
### Avoiding Contact

A boat must avoid contact with another boat if reasonably possible. Even a ROW boat must attempt to avoid contact when it becomes clear to her that the give-way boat is not keeping clear. (Rule 14)

## RRS- The basics (cont.)

### Rule 10- on opposite tacks

"When boats are on opposite tacks, a port tack boat shall keep clear of a starboard tack boat"



### Definition of Tack

A boat is on the tack starboard or port, corresponding to her windward side. Her windward side is the side opposite the side on which her main sail lies.

In the diagrams above, the yellow boats are on starboard tack and the blue boats must keep clear.

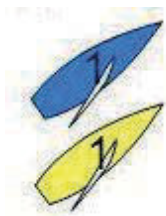
### Rule 11- on the same tack, overlapped

"When boats are on the same tack and overlapped, a windward boat shall keep clear of a leeward boat"

### Definition of Overlap

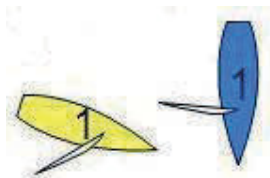
Boats overlap when neither is clear astern when sailing on:

- (a) the same tack;
- (b) opposite tacks sailing off the wind or when about to round a mark;
- (c) when a boat between them overlaps both.



In the diagram on the left, the boats are overlapped and Blue is to windward. Rule 11 therefore applies and Blue must keep clear.

The boats on the right are and on the same port tack windward boat must keep



also overlapped, and Blue being the clear.

## RRS- The basics (cont.)

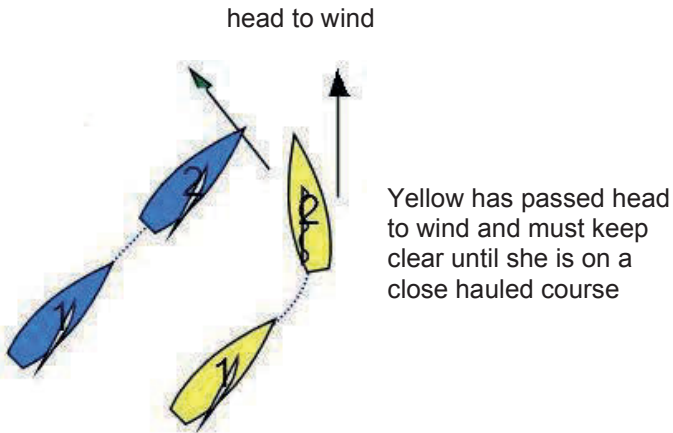
### Rule 12- on the same tack, not overlapped

"When boats are on the same tack and not overlapped, a boat clear astern shall keep clear of a boat clear ahead".



### Rule 13- while tacking

"After a boat passes head to wind she shall keep clear of other boats until she is on a close hauled course"

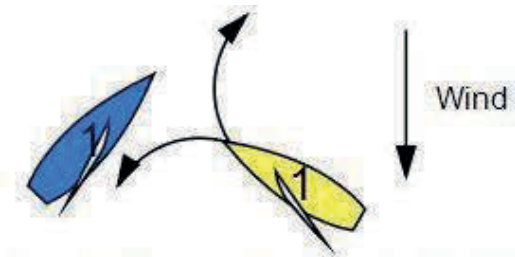


When a boat alters course to windward she is said to be "luffing". When she passes head to wind she is said to be "tacking" until she reaches a close hauled course.

## RRS- The basics (cont.)

### Rule 14- avoiding contact

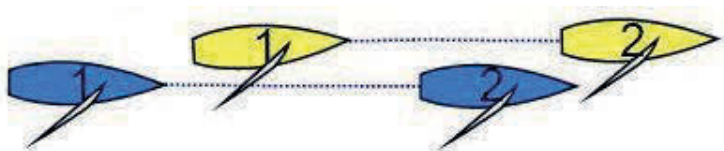
"A boat must avoid contact with another boat if reasonably possible. Even a boat with right of way must try to avoid contact when it becomes clear to her that the other boat is not keeping clear"



In the diagram above, Yellow has ROW but Blue is not keeping clear and so breaks rule 10. If there is contact Blue also breaks Rule 14. But Yellow must also try to avoid contact by either luffing or bearing away as illustrated -otherwise she too might break rule 14.

### Rule 15- acquiring right of way

"When a boat acquires right of way, she shall initially give the other boat room to keep clear, unless she acquires right of way because of the other boat's actions"

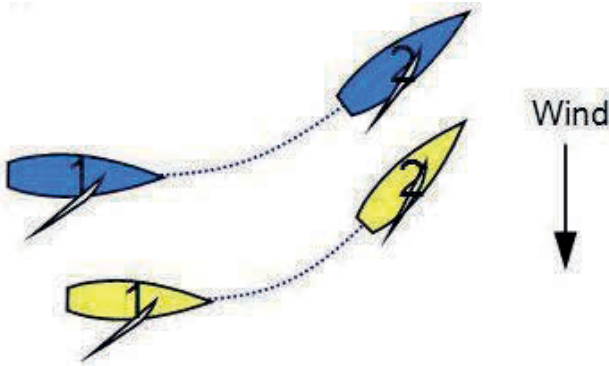


In the above diagram yellow is clear ahead and ROW. Blue is sailing faster than Yellow and becomes overlapped to leeward of Yellow and so the ROW changes to Blue. However, Blue must initially give Yellow room to keep clear.

## RRS- The basics (cont.)

### Rule 16- changing course

"When a right of way boat changes course, she shall give the other boat room to keep clear."

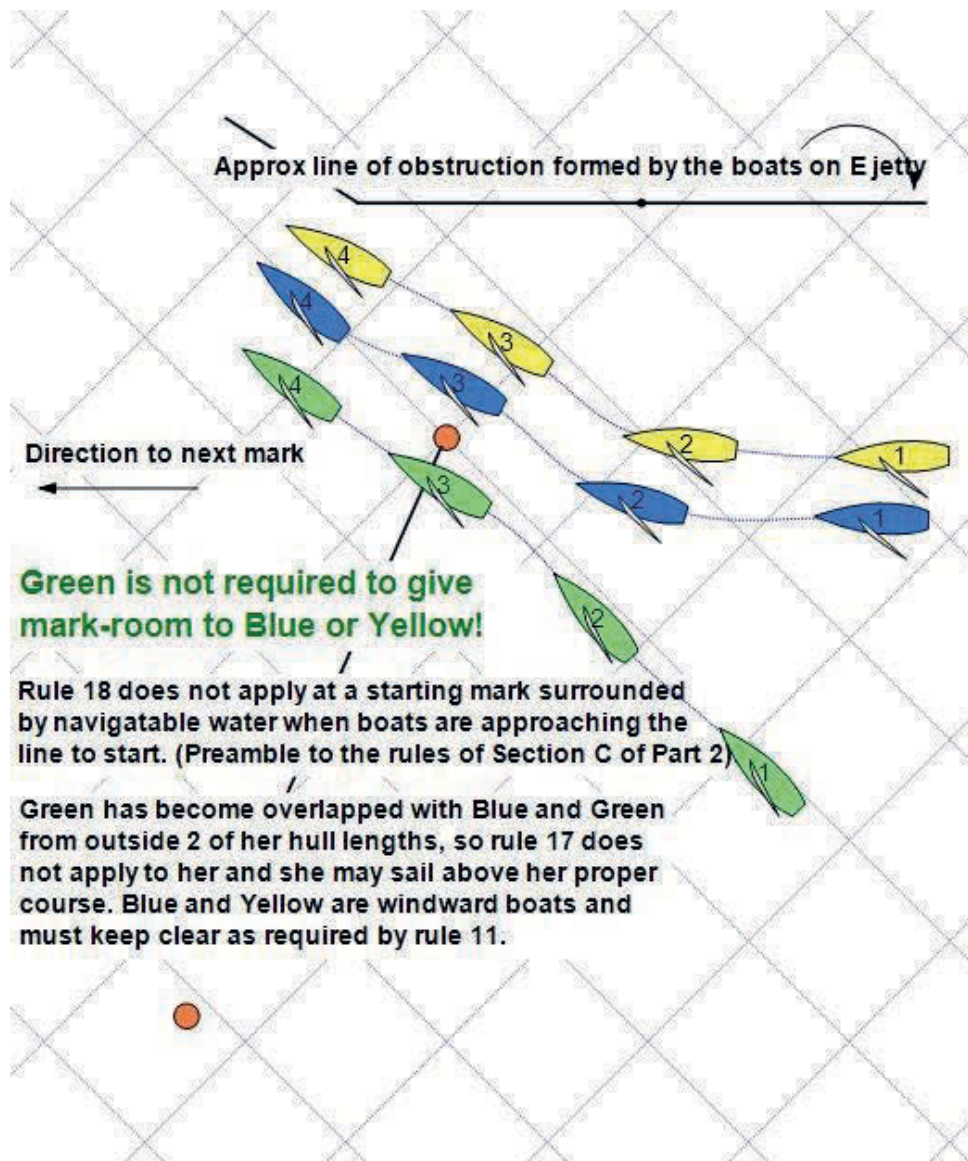


In the diagram above, Yellow (leeward & ROW) changes course to windward by luffing. Blue responds promptly by luffing and in so doing keeps clear. The ROW boat must give room for the other boat to keep clear and the other boat must respond promptly and do everything within reason to keep clear.

The fore-going handy hints for rules 10 through 16 are intended to provide Members with the bare essentials necessary to avoid contact with other boats whilst racing.

There are, however, 28 rules in the "When boats meet" section of the rules, many of which limit or modify how rules 10 to 16 apply, such as at marks and obstructions.

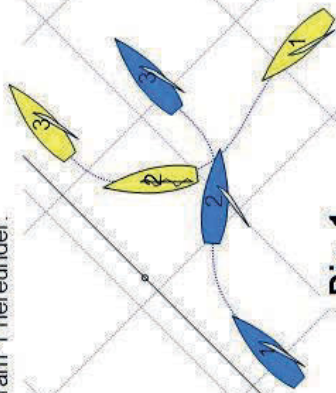
It is essential, therefore, that Members become fully conversant with all the racing rules and so ensure everyone's safe enjoyment of sailing.



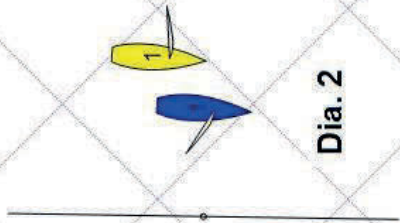


In diagram 1, rule 19.2 (room to pass an obstruction ) does not apply as the boats are not overlapped ( see definition overlap). Rule 10 applies!

When boats are on a beat the port tack boat must plan ahead because it is no defence to claim "I don't have room to tack". If a boat in Blue's position does not have room to tack, she must bear away as in the diagram 1 hereunder.

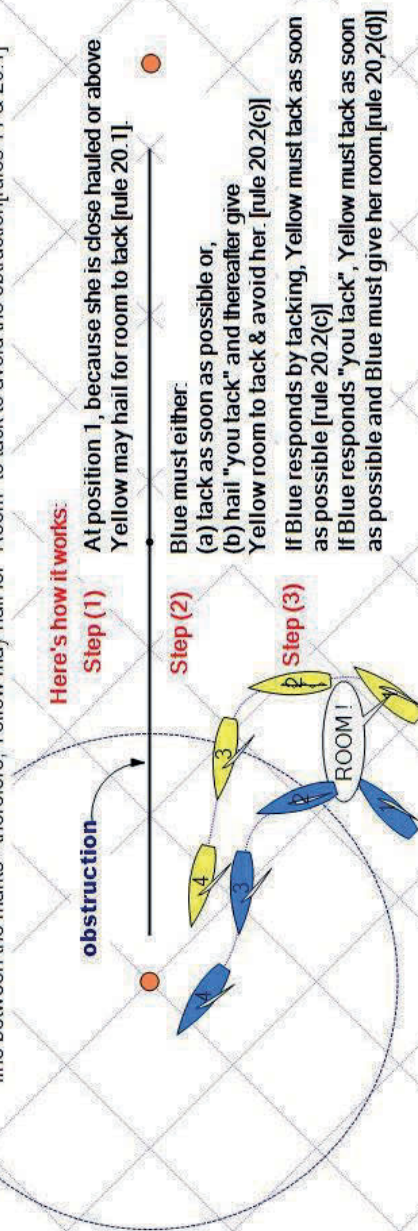

In diagram 2 above Blue and Yellow are overlapped and Yellow must give Blue room to pass the obstruction, even though they are on opposite tacks. The definition "overlap" states that boats on opposite tacks can be overlapped when they are sailing at more than 90 degrees to the wind. Prior to becoming overlapped, rule 10 applies and port tack must keep clear of starboard tack.

## Dealing with the obstruction between "Brickie" A & B

RPYC sailing instruction 10.10 states "boats shall not cross the imaginary line between Brick Landing A & B Buys (33A & 33B) which line is deemed an Obstruction".

In the diagram hereunder, Yellow and Blue are close hauled and approaching an obstruction - the imaginary line between the marks - therefore, Yellow may hail for "Room" to tack to avoid the obstruction [rules 11 & 20.1]



Note that rule 20 - hailing for room to tack at an obstruction - applies to the above situation whether one of the boats is in the zone or not

## Dealing with the obstruction between Smith and Lucky Bay buoys.

**RPYC Sailing Instruction 10.11 states that boats shall not cross the imaginary line between Smith 35A and Lucky Bay 33B**

Aqua & Grey are overlapped. Aqua is leeward ROW and Grey must keep clear [RRS11] and give room at the obstruction [RRS 19.2]

SW Wind Direction

Green and Pink are on a beat, on opposite tacks so rule 18 doesn't apply. Pink is ROW starboard & Green must keep clear. [RRS 10] and Green gets no protection from rule 19 or 20 because of the obstruction.

35A Smith Buoy

In the position on the left, Yellow is close hauled and may hail for room to tack at the obstruction - the imaginary line between the marks - to avoid a boat on the same tack. [Rule 20 applies]

The hailed boat must respond by either tacking ASAP or hailing "YOU TACK!" and giving room for the hailed boat to keep clear.

35B Lucky Bay Buoy

**The imaginary line Obstruction between Smith & Lucky Bay is not part of either buoy and is not a continuing obstruction**
