On-Water Instructions

Radio communications will be on VHF Channel 77

1. COMMENCEMENT

All boats to congregate on the western side of Matilda Bay near the moorings. The allocated VIP Boats will be instructed to raft together on the North (city) side of the Sail Past starting point. Instructions will come across on **VHF Channel 77**.

2. SAIL PAST

The Sail Past will commence at 1500hrs. The fleet will be lead by **RPYC Challenger**. Participating boats are then to follow, in a single line, past the transoms of the rafted VIP Boats. Boats are reminded to keep their speed and wake down during the Sail Past.

3. FLOTILLA

Boats participating in the Sail Past are invited to follow the designated Flotilla route towards Elizabeth Quay. Boats that did not participate in the Sail Past may join in the Flotilla once the Sail Past has cleared (eastern side of the RPYC Starters Box). The VIP Boats will follow the main group upon hauling anchor.

The intention of the Flotilla is to cruise at approximately 6knots, suitably spaced in a bow to stern line to ensure a comfortable cruise for all participants.

4. PERTH YACHT CLUB (PYC) SITE PAUSE

Boats that are able to pass under the Narrows Bridge are asked to congregate in front of the old Perth Yacht Club (PYC) site, which was at the base of William Street, south of Elizabeth Quay. RPYC staff, Travis Burtenshaw and Dana Jolliffe, will be in the area on an **RPYC RIB** and will be taking photos of the Flotilla in this area. Communication will be on VHF Channel 77.

5. NARROWS BRIDGE TURN

Boats that are unable to pass under the Narrows Bridge are asked to gather for a photo opportunity on the western side of the Narrows Bridge. RPYC staff, Travis Burtenshaw and Dana Jolliffe, will communicate via VHF Channel 77 from an **RPYC RIB** to coordinate photos of the Flotilla in this area.

6. RETURN TO RPYC

RPYC Challenger will lead the fleet back to RPYC Crawley. Boats are asked to follow Challenger on return to Matilda Bay. Communication will be on VHF Channel 77.

7. AVAILABLE BERTHS

The availability of empty pens are limited at RPYC and any available space will be on a first come basis. We recommend making arrangements for your boat for the event.

8. MAP

All boats shall follow the course indicated on the Course Route Map below, in a single-boat formation.
