# Commodore's list

## Fraser Gallop Estate - Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA 70

With this single vineyard handpicked Chardonnay FGE wish to downplay the influence of oak and let the pristine fruit flavours take the main stage.

## Happs - Bone Dry Rose, Margaret River 60

A perfect wine for a charcuterie platter, summer salads and wasrm days with friends

## Penny's Hill - 'Skeleton Key' Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA 80

Deliberately long-aged expression of the cumulative best from their McLaren Vale vineyard site, 'Skeleton Key' is cellared and carefully bottle-aged before it is unlocked. Awarded 95 points by James Halliday, an outstanding wine.

## Shaw & Smith - Sauvignon Blanc, Adelaide Hills, SA 75

The current vintage has lemon, lime and pink grapefruit aromas and real persistence of flavour. Great balance with bright acidity.

## Devils Corner - 'Resolution' Pinot Noir, Tasmania 75

Resolution Pinot Noir displays vibrant cherry, red berry and subtle spice aromas combined with a savoury, balanced, and lingering palate. Winner of the Bronze medal Royal Hobart Nine Show 2021.

## Singlefile - Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, Franklin River, WA 75

The colour is light, bright and glistening. displaying aromatics of gooseberries and tropical fruit. The palate shows a textural mouth feel which lingers to a refreshing dry finish.

## Singlefile - Cabernet Merlot, Franklin River, WA 75

This wine displays bright and lifted aromas of dark berry and bay leaf, and gentle oak support.

## Mazza Tempranillo, Geographe, WA 65

This vibrant medium-bodied wine has an aroma of dark cherries and gentle spices. The palate is loaded with rich, plummy fruit, smooth tannins, and pleasing complexity.

## McHenry Hohnen 'Laterite Hills' Chardonnay, Margaret River 80

Complex and very satisfying, this is a charming Southern Margaret River Chardonnay All fruit was hand-picked and whole bunch pressed, before undergoing wild yeast fermentation in French oak barriques (25% new).

## McHenry Hohnen 'Hazels Vineyard' Zinfandel, Margaret River 100

This fruit driven Zinfandel is guaranteed to please as a young wine but will improve with careful cellaring over the years.

## Nanny Goat - 'Super Nanny' Pinot Noir, Central Otago, NZ, 140

Big, bold and full of all the black fruits, namely cherries, the Super Nanny is tempered with subtle notes of leather, spice and oak. Fine tannins and juicy acidity join forces to give it a long, clean finish.

## Shiraz

Single Vinyard, medium bodied wine, but still with distinctive power and concentration of refined primary fruits. Fantastic lively & textural tannins, supporting the fruit, right through to the finish.
