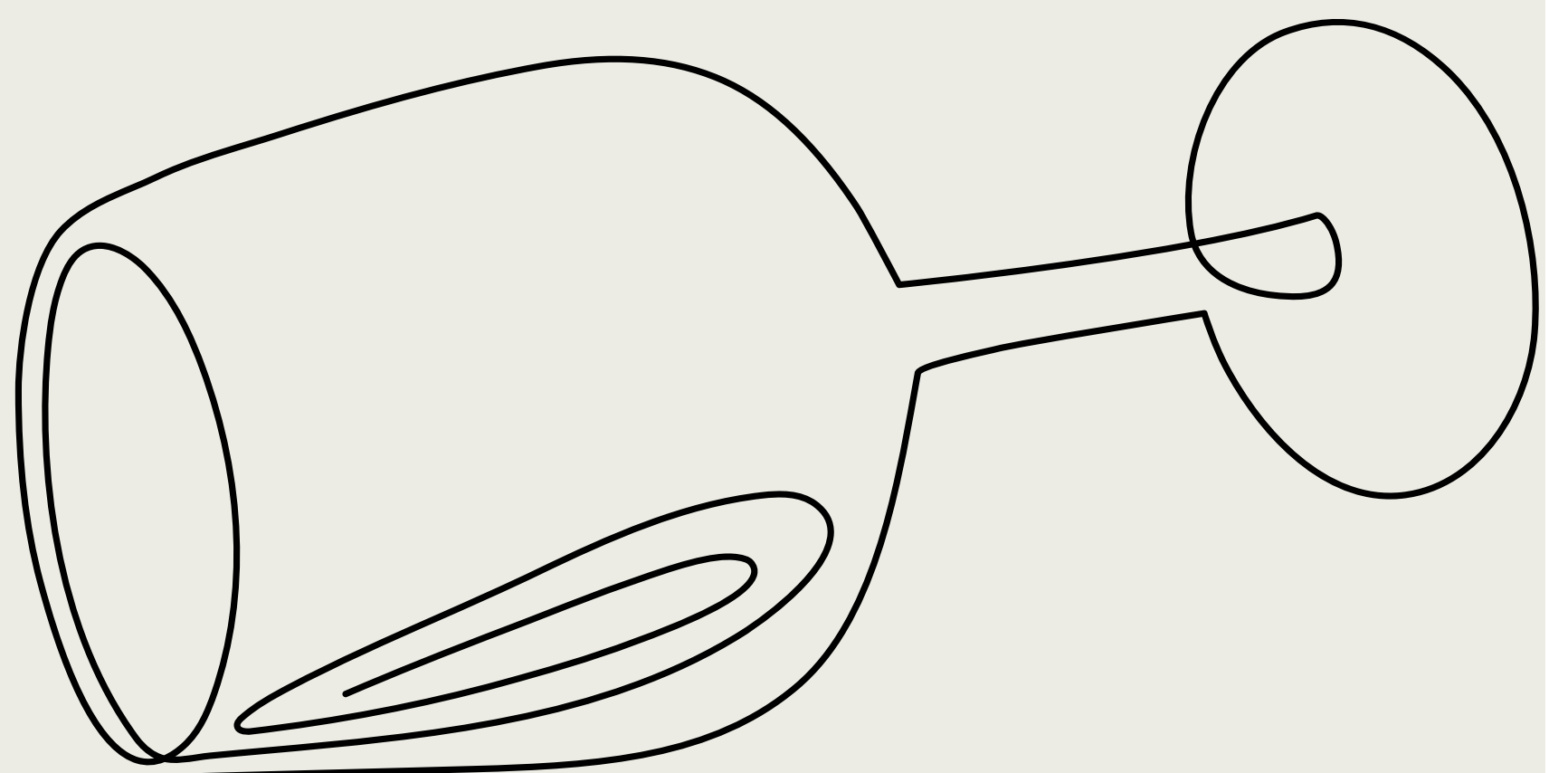

Fraser Gallop Estate - Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA

70

With this single vineyard handpicked Chardonnay FGE wish to downplay the influence of oak and let the pristine fruit flavours take the main stage.

Decibel - Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay, NZ

50

The nose shows lemongrass, kaffir lime and red grapefruit
Hints of crisp nectarine, rich nougat and citrus rind evolve

Swings & Roundabouts 'Backyard Stories' Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA

65

Fine and pure Chardonnay fruit aromas of white stone fruits, some lifted floral aromas and mealy complexity complemented with integrated high quality French oak.

Shaw & Smith - Sauvignon Blanc, Adelaide Hills, SA

75

The current vintage has lemon, lime and pink grapefruit aromas and real persistence of flavour. Great balance with bright acidity.

Singlefile - Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, Franklin River, WA

75

The colour is light, bright and glistening. displaying aromatics of gooseberries and tropical fruit. The palate shows a textural mouth feel which lingers to a refreshing dry finish.

Singlefile - Cabernet Merlot, Franklin River, WA

75

This wine displays bright and lifted aromas of dark berry and bay leaf, and gentle oak support.

Mazza Tempranillo, Geographe, WA

65

This vibrant medium-bodied wine has an aroma of dark cherries and gentle spices. The palate is loaded with rich, plummy fruit, smooth tannins, and pleasing complexity.

Nanny Goat - 'Super Nanny' Pinot Noir, Central Otago, NZ,

140

Big, bold and full of all the black fruits, namely cherries,
the Super Nanny is tempered with subtle notes of leather, spice and oak.

Swings & Roundabouts, NV Sparkling, WA

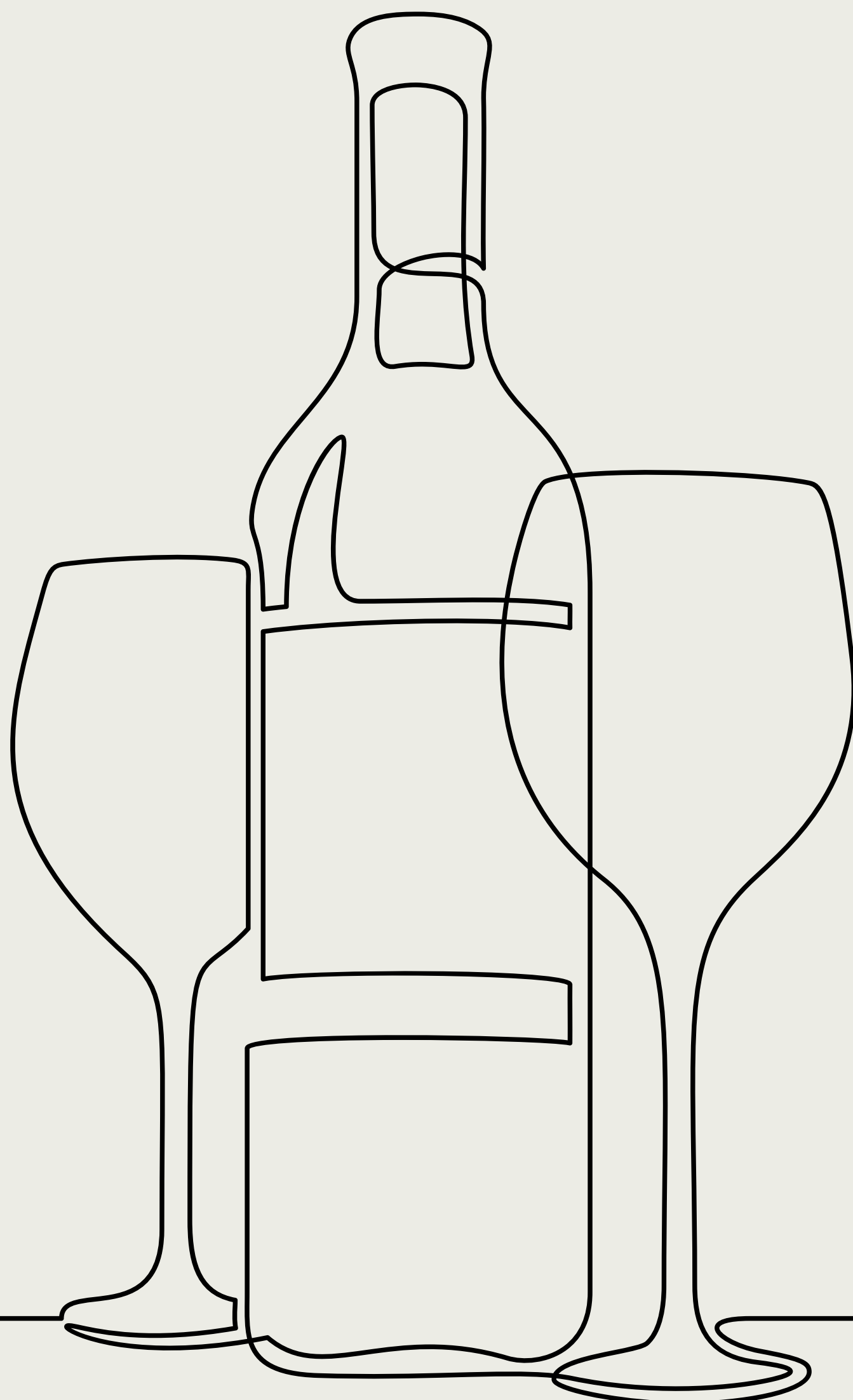

Howard Park - Grenache, Swan Valley, WA

12

Sweet, juicy fruit flows over the palate which is light to medium-bodied. The red berries are balanced nicely with brambly, peppery spice and soft tannins which continue through the long and fruity finish

Little Giant - Pinot Noir, SA

10

Reminiscent of the vibrancy, passion and energy of Spain, this wine is a smooth, fruit-driven red wine balancing notes of blackberry and plum with delicate spice.

Xanadu Circa 77 – Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River WA

The generous palate is packed full of juicy fruits of the forest, cassis and chocolate characters. Medium to full-bodied, the fleshy fruits are supported by moreish, supple and ripe tannins.

Origins - Shiraz - Heathcote, VIC

Vibrant, yet sweet palate, full of dark fruit flavours , hints of pepper with a fresh blueberry finish. This wine has smooth tannins and a soft mouth feel.

St Hallett - ‘Black Clay’ - Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA

10

The black cracking Biscay clay of the Barossa Valley gives Black Clay Shiraz it's unique berry compote and summer pudding flavours, complemented by luscious velvety tannins.

Rockbare - Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA

12

Single Vinyard, medium bodied wine, but still with distinctive power and concentration of refined primary fruits. Fantastic lively & textural tannins, supporting the fruit, right through to the finish.

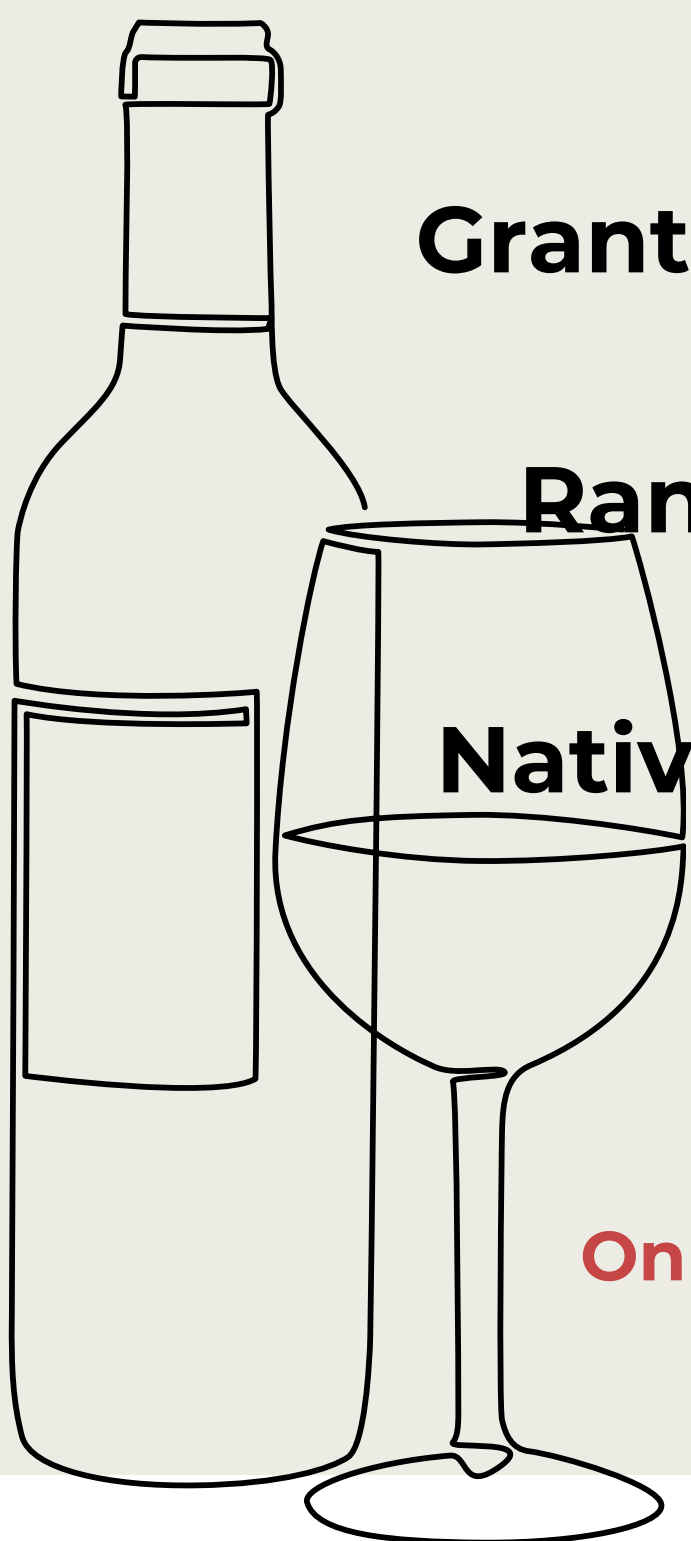

Marchand & Burch - Blanc de Blanc NV, France **80**

The Crémant de Bourgogne is a blend of Chardonnay, Gamay, Pinot Noir and Aligoté. . The aromas of red summer berries are accompanied by those of sherbet, apple strudel and waterfall mist.

Moët & Chandon - Brut Champagne, France **130**

Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial with its perfect balance of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier has become one of the world's most loved Champagnes.

Veuve Clicquot - Brut Champagne, France **150**

Veuve Clicquot is the enduring homage to the great Madame Barbe-Nicole Clicquot. A wonderful celebration Champagne.

Xanadu Circa 77 – Rose, Margaret River WA

Rameau D'or - Rosè, Cote De Provence, France

60

Dry, delicate Rosé showing the traditional tones of rose from the sunny Provence area of Southern France. Notes of wild strawberries and delicate spicy notes. An outstanding Southern French Rosé.

Pinot Grigio/ Riesling

Tachillia White Admiral - Pinot Grigio, S

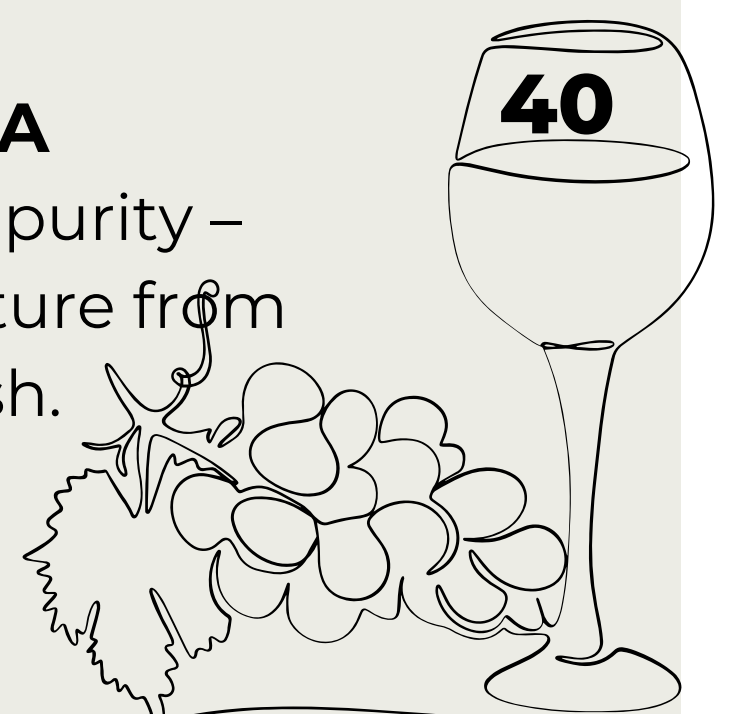

Chardonnay

Houghton - Reserve Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA

35

Classic Houghton Reserve is a fresh, vibrant expression of a West Australian Chardonnay.

Forest Hill - 'Highbury Fields' Chardonnay, Mount Barker, WA

55

Bright straw with green hues. Aromas of white stone fruit, citrus peel with some nutty complexity. Multiple award winning Chardonnay, year in year out.

Pinot Noir/Tempranillo

Brown Brothers Origins - Tempranillo, VIC

40

Reminiscent of the vibrancy, passion and energy of Spain, this wine is a smooth, fruit-driven red wine balancing notes of blackberry and plum with delicate spice.

Little Giant - Pinot Noir, SA

50

Using grapes grown in Adelaide Hills and Langhorne Creek, this is a gorgeously fruit forward on the nose showing sweet cherry, raspberry, olive and floral notes.

Howard Park - Grenache, Swan Valley, WA

50

Sweet, juicy fruit flows over the palate which is light to medium-bodied. The red berries are balanced nicely with brambly, peppery spice and soft tannins which continue through the long and fruity finish

Cabernet Merlot/ Sauvignon

Xanadu Circa 77 – Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River WA **40**

The generous palate is packed full of juicy fruits of the forest, cassis and chocolate characters. Medium to full-bodied, the fleshy fruits are supported by moreish, supple and ripe tannins.

Swings & Roundabouts - Cabernet Merlot, Margaret River,WA **40**

The classic Margaret River red blend this example is an excellent drink now style. The bouquet offers an array of fruits including raspberry and plum and the palate shows fresh flavours balanced with dusty tannins.

Credaro '5 Tales' - Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, WA **45**

A supple palate with cherry and dark plum characters, finishing gently with very soft tannins and creamy vanilla nuances. A flavoursome red blend with instant drinking appeal.

Howard Park - 'Miamup' Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, WA **55**

One of the stalwarts of the Margaret River wine making region, highly rated in James Halliday's Wine Companion with average scores in the mid 90's.

Shiraz

Hardys 'The Riddle' - Shiraz, SA **20**

With plum and mulberry characteristics this Shiraz is easy on the palate with soft tannins underpinning a slightly dry finish.

Origins- Shiraz, Heathcote, VIC **30**

Vibrant yet sweet palate, full of dark fruit flavours, hints of pepper with a fresh blueberry finish. This wine has soft tannins and a soft mouth feel.

St Hallett, 'Black Clay' - Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA **55**

The black cracking Biscay clay of the Barossa Valley gives Black Clay Shiraz its unique berry compote and summer pudding flavours, complemented by luscious velvety tannins.

Rockbare - Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA **60**

Single Vinyard, medium bodied wine, but still with distinctive power and concentration of refined primary fruits. Fantastic lively & textural tannins, supporting the fruit, right through to the finish.

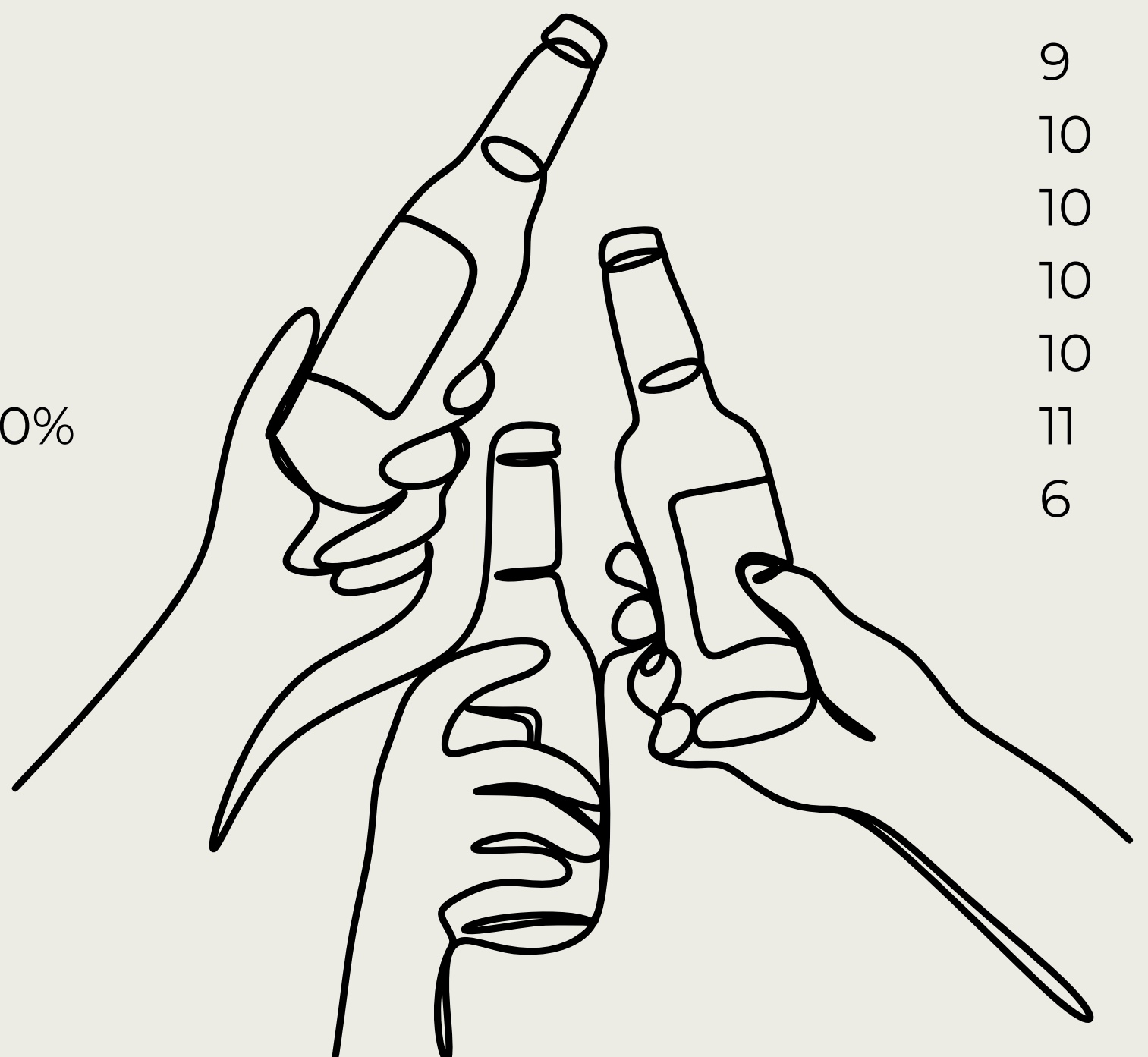
